


VA Education Beneficiaries






Monday Morning Workload Report

Pending Legislation in the 110th Congress

- HR 67- Improve outreach activities
- HR 81- Transferability, increase MGIB rates annually based on average costs of higher learning
- HR 100- Prevent veteran contributions to education benefits from reducing Federal student financial assistance
- HR 112- Stipends for veterans who pursue doctoral degrees in science or technology
- HR 1102- Make MGIB-SR and REAP part of Title 38
- S 22- Amend Title 38, USC, to include the costs of tuition, room and board, and a monthly stipend of \$1,000. Give a 15-year delimiting date for MGIB
